## Communicating Powerful Messages 1 -Swansong by Christopher Bruce

We learn about another thought-provoking piece of professional dance called Swansong choreographed by Christopher Bruce. Looking at the theme of 'Interrogation', exploring the use of contact improvisation and use of props to express this theme safely and effectively to an audience through the use of movement and production design. Building on your knowledge and skills in contemporary dance.

### Communicating Powerful Messages 2 - BLM by Ashley Banjo

We learn about the thought-provoking dance piece BLM created by Ashley Banjo in 2020. We learn dance phrases from this professional dance, identify the key themes in this work and how to express them through your own choreographic ideas and the use of production features such as lighting, props and set.
